On behalf of the six University of California business schools, we invite your school to partner with us in an important initiative. In 2012, we launched a Summer Institute for Emerging Managers and Leaders (SIEML) for undergraduates. Selected students attend a series of classes at the host UC business school for two weeks, during two consecutive summers. Each of the six business schools rotates as host. This year the program will be hosted by the UC San Diego Rady School of Management.

This program is open to candidates from Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSI). The program includes an all-expenses-paid fellowship for the selected students over the two summers.

Highly talented students who are finishing their freshman year at your institution are eligible to apply. The 2015 program will have 50 total students in the continuing and entering cohorts. This year we are admitting 27 new students. **We invite your best students to experience the excellence of the UC business schools and the opportunities we offer.**

The SIEML program was developed with considerable input from community and business leaders who understand the needs for such a program. The program includes interactions with influential business leaders on the West Coast, including representatives of major companies like Deloitte and Wells Fargo as well as of established and emerging companies in technology, life sciences, and alternative energy. California represents the industries and ideas of the future, where diverse and creative perspectives combine to fuel the innovations of tomorrow. The UC business schools are key drivers of this innovation economy, and we encourage your students to experience these exciting opportunities firsthand.
